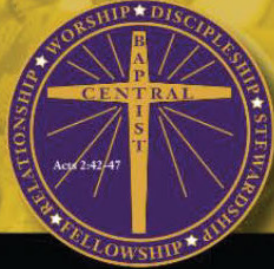

1. Check your blood pressure regularly.

If you have high blood pressure, make dietary changes, be physically active and take meds as prescribed.

2. If overweight, focus on the quality of your diet and again be physically active.

Avoid empty calories & unhealthy snacking.

Again, regular exercise, diet and taking meds as prescribed are key.



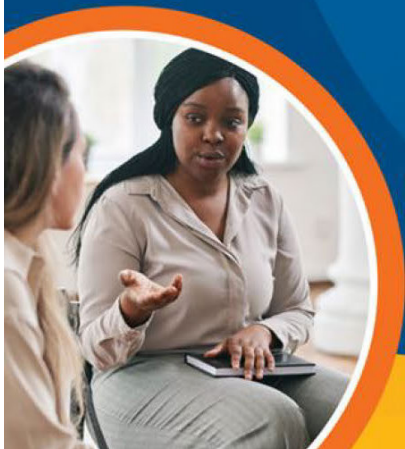
